## IV. MAYOR'S REPORT:

- Due to the collapse of the recycling market, Maggio's has proposed comingling trash and recycling, with pick-ups 2 days a week instead of 3. This will then be separated at their new plant, which the Board is planning to visit next week to see the process. Our current refuse contract expires in June & bids for a new contract will be sought in the spring.
- The Board met with a representative of Fundamental Business Service, Inc. (FBS) and we will be signing an agreement with them to take over the collection of parking tickets. They will get a percentage of any late payments they collect.
- We are continuing our work on the no soliciting signs
- As of January 1, a new state law goes into effect that will dictate how often the Village must hold court. This new law states court must be held at least every 21 days and will force us to now have court twice a month.

#### V. COMMISSIONER'S REPORTS:

- **1. BEACH:** Some sand was lost during the last storm, but no damage to any equipment.
- **2. CONSTABULARY:** November had only 26 calls for service, 15 summonses issued and 560 house checks.
